Introductory Overview

The Catholic Cemeteries of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee announce a new mausoleum project — the expansion of the mausoleum at Mount Olivet Cemetery in Milwaukee, comprising almost 2,200 new crypts and over 650 niches for cremation urns.



As the Archdiocesan Catholic cemetery for the parishes in southwest Milwaukee County, Mount Olivet enters a fifth phase of mausoleum construction. The last phase brought the Chapel of Angels & Light Mausoleum into existence.

Why A Catholic Cemetery?

A Catholic cemetery serves the Church through the ministry of consolation — reverent burial of the faithful departed and compassionate care of the living faithful. We extend this care to all God's people...no matter their station in life...as a sign of Christ's unconditional love and gentle mercy. 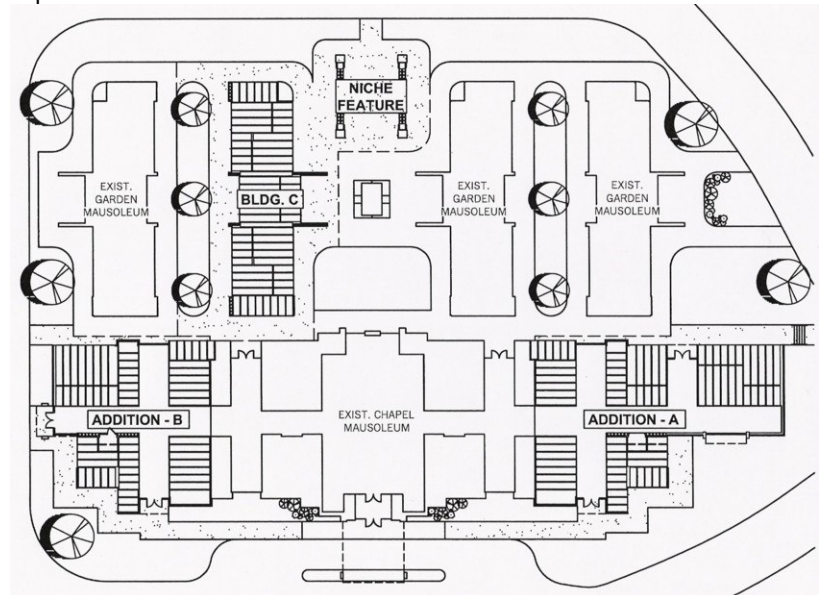
An Opportunity To Finish Your Advance Burial Planning

Four Project Components

Two new additions will flank the Chapel of Angels & Light Mausoleum. Constructing a fourth free-standing mausoleum will complete the set of outdoor patios, and a niche feature will finish and enhance the eastern courtyard. So, there are four parts to a single expansion project.

1. Addition A lower right of plan

This portion will add three new interior corridors and two patios as the Chapel expands to the south. Niches are also included.



Note: **North** is to left on plan

2. Addition B lower left of plan

On the north side of the chapel, this expansion wing will include three inside corridors along with two outside patios. Interior niches are part of this addition.

3. Building C left center of plan

To complete our long-range plan, we are adding the last outside patio building to match the three existing buildings, adding four new patios of crypts and niches.

4. Niche Feature upper center of plan

To complement the existing Archangel Columbarium, we will build a 304-niche feature columbarium in the courtyard. As a new option, many niches throughout the expansion will be double-wide — “deluxe companion” niches.

Why is this happening?

We want to meet the need for above-ground burial space on the south side of Milwaukee, a place where preference for crypts and niches has been strong since the 1970s. Of course, we have always offered graves for in-ground burial.

These pre-need crypts and niches present an opportunity for cost savings while completing your advance burial arrangements. We are offering pre-construction pricing at substantial savings if you purchase pre-need. Bear in mind, if an untimely death occurs before completion of the new crypts or niches, a temporary



placement will be provided until the permanent placement can be made in the newly-constructed space.

Pre-Construction Sales opened on October 15, 2006.

Cremated Remains Above-Ground

- ❖ Single Niches
- ❖ “Deluxe Companion” Niches (*two spaces, side-by-side*)
